On Saturday 5th February there will be a workshop with David le Page and a masterclass with Tasmin Little culminating in a performance featuring all the workshop participants, David, Tasmin and the three lucky violinists chosen for the masterclass.

This event should be of equal interest to teachers, students and young aspiring string players.

Workshop with David le Page

Saturday 5th February 2011 10:30-14:30

Any ESTA members who has had the chance to work with David le Page on an ESTA Summer School, at the recent Fundraising Day in Watford or indeed at Grittleton Chamber Music courses already knows how wonderfully he works with musicians at all stages along the learning continuum, quite literally from beginner to professional.

The workshop will be for violin, viola, cello and double bass players grade 3-8+ and aged 8-18. During the workshop students will prepare his newly commissioned piece for string orchestra and two solo violins. David le Page and Tasmin Little will perform the solo parts on this occasion.
